Meetings

The Board held two meetings this year, in April and November. We are grateful for the strong sense of unity among the members regarding the vision and mission of the DRTS. Our hope and prayer is that the Lord will continue to guide and bless this work.

Current Projects

The Board is pleased to announce that Volume 5 of Mastricht's magnum opus has been completed and is now in the editing phase. The final two volumes (6 and 7) are also in the editing stage.

New Translation Projects

The translation into English of the *Acta Authentica*—the original Acts of the Synod of Dort (1618-1619), which are the minutes officially approved by the Synod, have started.

Furthermore, the undertaking of a major work by Gisbertus Voetius (1589-1676), *Ta Askètika sive Exercitia Pietatis* (*The Practice of Godliness*, 1664) is on its way. In this book, Voetius delves into the practical aspects of a faithful Christian life. He addresses subjects such as prayer, devotion, meditation, overcoming temptations, delivering sermons, as well as the practice of Baptism, the Lord's Supper, and pastoral visitation.
